The European Commission 'Calls for Proposals' is the preferred mechanism by which many of the Directorate Generals invite bids for funding which, in delivery, achieve the Commission Objectives.

The bidding process is typically very competitive, conformance to the rules is essential if you are not to be excluded on a technicality, and deadlines can be tight. Please note that a number of Calls have deadlines in late February/March 2010 and these have been highlighted in **BOLD**.

The following tables summarise those currently 'live' calls, but a link is provided to the primary information source.

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Lifelong Learning Programme (LLP) - €2,787 million for European cooperation

The Lifelong Learning Programme supports education and training. The objective is to reinforce the contribution made by education and training to achieving the Lisbon goal of *'making the EU the most competitive knowledge-based economy, with sustainable economic development, more and better jobs, and greater social cohesion'*.

There are four sub-programmes:

- Comenius** - project-based partnerships, in-service opportunities and assistantships for all levels of school and further education
- Erasmus** - supports the mobility of HE students and staff across Europe, for both work placement and study purposes
- Leonardo** - for the development of vocational skills and training
- Grundtvig** - supports partnerships and training opportunities for adult education organisations, teachers and learners

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The 'Europe for Citizens' programme supports a wide range of activities and organisations promoting "active European citizenship", especially the involvement of citizens and civil society organisations in the process of European integration.

The programme has a budget of €215 millions started on 1 January 2007 and ends on 31 December 2013. It supports four main types of actions:

[Action 1 - Active Citizens for Europe](#): involving citizens either through activities linked to town-twinning or through other kinds of citizens' projects.

[Action 2 - Active civil society in Europe](#): targeted to civil society organisations either through structural support on the basis of their European level work programme or through support to [projects](#).

[Action 3 - Together for Europe](#): including high visibility events, studies and information tools.

[Action 4 - Active European Remembrance](#): support to projects aiming at preserving the sites and archives associated with the deportations as well as the commemorating of victims of Nazism and Stalinism.

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INTERREG IVc - THIRD CALL FOR PROJECTS

The third call for Capitalisation projects was launched on 9 December 2009 during the INTERREG IVc 'Capitalisation Conference' held in Gothenburg, Sweden. The call targeted Managing Authorities of Structural Funds programmes and local and regional authorities with good practices to share.

The call targets interregional cooperation projects which focus on the transfer of good practices, which were previously developed and identified by the partners, into the mainstream Structural Funds programmes in the participating regions. The recently published guide http://www.interreg4c.net/load/Capitalisation_brochure_2009.pdf provides an overview for the applicants which are based on the 6 Capitalisation projects from the first INTERREG IVc call.

The 'Call' will close on **5th March 2010**.

Seventh Framework Programme Calls for Proposals Summer 2009

On 30 July 2009 the European Commission (EC) announced 53 calls for proposals under the FP7 programme. FP7 is the EU's main instrument for funding research in Europe in the period 2007-2013 and it is designed to respond to Europe's employment needs, competitiveness, and its quality of life. Deadlines for some of the calls have now passed and there is limited time for many which remain.
